Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth Grade Homework Policy

Homework is an educationally valid extension of the instructional program of the school and will be a part of every student's educational program. The purpose of homework is to provide essential practice in basic skills, enrich and extend classroom learning, reinforce independent study skills, and develop initiative, responsibility, and self-direction. In accordance with school policy, your child should have 60 minutes of homework per night. Most homework assignments begin immediately after instruction, so the teacher will be available to answer any questions regarding procedure with the remainder of the assignment to be completed at home. Homework assignments will be graded and returned to your child as feedback. Homework counts as 30% of your child's grade during every marking period. Homework can help your child receive a good grade or, if not completed, can keep your child from receiving one.

Homework Specifics for Students

- Students will do homework on their own and to the best of their ability.
- Students will turn in homework on time.
- Students are responsible for making up homework assignments missed due to absences according to school policy.
- Students will receive a zero (0) grade for missing assignments.
- Students may turn in a homework assignment late for a maximum grade of a 70.
